

**SKIPPACK TOWNSHIP  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
ORDINANCE NO. 302**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SKIPPACK CHAPTER 187, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, TO ADD SECTION 187-14-1 TO PROVIDE FOR MULTI-WAY STOP CONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION OF SIGNS CONSISTENT WITH SUCH DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS AND AMEND ARTICLE VII TO ADD SECTION 187-59, SCHEDULE XIX TO LIST ESTABLISHED MULTI-WAY STOP CONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, Skippack Township is a Township of the Second Class organized and existing under the laws of Pennsylvania, located in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania; and

**WHEREAS**, Skippack Township Board of Supervisors has commissioned a traffic and engineering study of the numerous intersections in Skippack Township for the purpose of determining whether Multi-way stop control is warranted; and

**WHEREAS**, Traffic Planning and Design, Inc., the Township Traffic Engineer, has conducted an engineering and traffic study of the intersection to determine whether a MULTI WAY stop control is warranted in accordance with 67 Pa. Code, Chapter 212 and Subchapter B of 212; and

**WHEREAS**, Traffic Planning and Design, Inc. has concluded in a report to the Township dated February 14, 2006, that Multi-way stop controls are warranted for various intersections in Skippack Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Skippack Township Board of Supervisors wish to amend The Code of the Township of Skippack, Chapter 187, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, to add Section 187-14-1 to provide for Multi-way stop controlled intersections and to authorize the installation of signs consistent with such designated intersections and to add Section 187-59, Schedule XIX.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Skippack, Montgomery County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained:

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the Township of Skippack, Chapter 187, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, shall be amended to add Section 187-14-1 and shall read as follows:

**§187-14-1. Multi-way Stop Controlled Intersections.**

The intersections described in Schedule XIX (§187-59), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby established as Multi-way stop controlled intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected in such a position as to face traffic approaching the intersection in said schedule. Every driver of a vehicle approaching any such intersection, from any direction, shall come to a full stop before entering any such intersection.

**SECTION 2.** The Code of the Township of Skippack, Chapter 187, Vehicles and Traffic, Article VII, shall be amended to add Section 187-59, Schedule XIX, Multi-way Stop Controlled Intersections, and shall read as follows:

**§187-59. Schedule XIX: Multi-way Stop Controlled Intersections.**

In accordance with the provisions of §187-14-1, the following described intersections are hereby established as Multi-way stop controlled intersections and stop signs shall be installed as provided therein:

**Name of Intersection**

- Village Avenue and Somerset Drive
- Village Avenue and Arbours Avenue
- Village Avenue and Twining Way

**SECTION 3. Severability.** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would still have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

**SECTION 4.** All other ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as provided by law.

**ORDAINED AND ENACTED** as an Ordinance by the Board of Supervisors of Skippack Township this 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2006.
