

**SKIPPACK TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 365**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SKIPPACK, CHAPTER 135, PEDDLING AND SOLICITING; TO REGULATE PEDDLING AND SOLICITING WITHIN SKIPPACK TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, Skippack Township is a Township of the Second Class organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, located in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township is empowered by Section 1601 of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code (the "Act"), 53 P.S. §66601, to enact ordinances in the exercise of general and specific powers allocated to the Township by terms of the Act, in an ongoing effort to promote, protect, and facilitate the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Skippack Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, after due consideration of this ordinance (the "Ordinance") at a duly advertised public meeting, has determined that the health, safety, and welfare of the Skippack Township residents will be served by the following amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors as follows:

SECTION 1. The Code of the Township of Skippack, Chapter 135, Peddling and Soliciting is hereby amended to replace the word "He" with the words "He/She", every place it appears; and to replace the word "His" with the words "His/Her", every place it appears.

SECTION 2. The Code of the Township of Skippack, Chapter 135, Peddling and Soliciting, §135-4.C is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"He/She shall not enter, attempt to enter, approach, or attempt to approach any dwelling or business house:

1. between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.;
2. any time on a Sunday;
3. without an invitation or permission of the occupant;
4. marked with a "No Solicitation" sign; and/or
5. included within any property association prohibiting peddling and solicitation,

and shall leave any above-described premises immediately upon request."

SECTION 3. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any section, sentence, clause, part, or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining

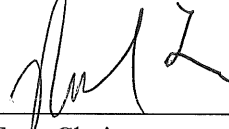
sections, sentences, clauses, or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would still have been adopted if such illegal or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part, or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Repealer. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as provided by law.
