

Why Update the Comprehensive Plan?



Bolsters likelihood of receiving grant funding for projects and recommendations in the Plan

Components of the Plan

- The MPC outlines several required elements of the plan:
 - A statement of objectives for future development and growth
 - A plan for land use
 - A plan for housing
 - A plan for **the movement of people and goods** (transportation)
 - A plan for **community facilities and utilities**
 - A plan for the protection of natural and historic resources
 - A statement of the interrelationships of plan components
 - A statement of consistency of existing and proposed development with contiguous municipalities
 - Implementation strategies

Skippack's Comprehensive Plan Update

Working Group

- The process typically starts with the formation of a working group comprised of township staff and the consultant team
- This working group helps guide the process of developing the plan, and select stakeholders
- A kickoff meeting will be held to introduce the planning process, expectations of the group, and visioning exercises to discuss strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats in the community
- Several meetings would follow, typically held monthly, to update the group on plan progress, receive feedback on findings, and discuss local issues
- Goals and objectives will be established early in the process with the group and revised as needed

Community Outreach

This is an important element of the comprehensive planning process

Several options are available including surveys, open houses, workshops, and presence at community events

Input from the community helps to ensure that the plan aligns with the vision all residents and the Township have for the future of Skippack



Once the plan had been drafted and revised, it will go through official review processes and presented to the Board of Supervisors for adoption

Skippack Township could greatly benefit from an up-to-date comprehensive plan that reflects the existing conditions, demographics, challenges, and opportunities to plan effectively for growth and establish a vision for the community
